Report on a collecting trip to Vietnam in 1990

Abstract: A brief report and an annotated list of collecting localities of the expedition is given. The main goals were to capture vertebrates and carry out ornithological observations, though invertebrates were also collected. Key words: Vietnam, zoological collecting, list of localities

Introduction

Within the framework of an agreement between the Hungarian Academy of Sciences and the National Center for Scientific Research of Vietnam, our expedition of the Hungarian Natural History Museum visited Vietnam in 1990. According to our original plan we wanted to arrive in Saigon but we got plane-tickets only to Hanoi. Despite our surprising arrival in the NSCR in Hanoi on 7th of November, the scientific staff of the Institute was very resilient. With their help we could join the expedition of five scientists of the Zoological Institute of Leningrad two days later.

We spent six days in Tam Dao (for the description of the locality see Mészáros *et al.* 1987) where we collected 11 mammalian and 30 bird species mainly by mist-net and during the investigation of bomb-shelters in and around the village. In addition we bought some shot animals from the villagers and collected insects at mercury-vapour lamp almost every night.

The second (and even shorter) trip was made to Quang Chu (for the description of the locality see Matskási *et al.* 1989). The trip in this promising place was pityfully short, but we could visit some caves and net birds during the one and half days there.

Finally, we made a short excursion to the Ha Long Bay, and after the total of 18 field-days we returned to Budapest on 23rd of November.

- No. 461-462. Same locality and date. Mist-netted birds (Ficedula monileger, Ficedula strophiata).
- No. 463. Same locality and date. Palm civet shot near the village (Paguma larvata).
- No. 464. Same locality and date. -Collected at light.
- No. 465-466. Same locality and date. Shot birds (Megalaima lagrandieri, Turdus sibiricus,).
- No. 467-474. Same locality and date. Mist-netted birds (Garrulax maesi, Stachyris chrysaea, Myophonus caeruleus, Otus scops, Alcippe morrisonia 2, Niltava sundara, Criniger ochraceus).
- No. 475. Same locality, 15. Nov. 1990. Newts from the stream (Paramesotriton deloustali).
- No. 476-481. Same locality and date. -Mist-netted birds (Zosterops erythropleura 2, Seicercus affinis, Yuhina zantholeuca, Phylloscopus proregulus, Brachypteryx leucophris).
- No. 482. Same locality, 16. Nov. 1990. Palm civet shot near the village (Paradoxurus hermaphroditus).
- No. 483. Same locality and date. A frog (Hylidae).
- No. 484. Vinh Phu Province, 15 km South of Tam Dao, 15. Nov. 1990. Grashoppers from a cave.
- No. 485. Same locality and date. Mist-netted bat at the entrance of the cave (Rhinolophus affinis).
- No. 486-491. Vinh Phu Province, Tam Dao, 16. Nov. 1990. -Mist-netted birds (Stachyris chrysaea 2, Stachyris nigriceps, Ficedula mugimaki, Seicercus affinis, Rhipidura albicollis).
- No. 492. Bac Thai Province, Quang Chu, 17. Nov. 1990. Mist-netted bird (indet).
- No. 493-496. Bac Thai Province, Hang Gioi (Bat Cave), 8 km E of Quang Chu, 17. Nov. 1990. Fruiteating bats, shot in the cave (*Rousettus amplexicaudatus*).
- No. 497. Same locality and date. Molluscs from the entrance of the cave.

No. 519. Quang Ninh Province, Hong Gai, 20. Nov. 1990. - Molluscs from the seashore.

No. 520. Quang Ninh Province, Yen Hung, 21. Nov. 1990. - Soil sample from a coniferous forest.

No. 521. Hanoi City, 23. Nov. 1990. - A mouse collected in the Hotel La Thanh (Mus musculus).

No. 522. Same locality and date. - Bird found on the bridge of the Red River (Motacilla alba).
